# Letter from TCM

Thank you very much for partnering with TCM through prayer, financial support, and telling others about TCM during 2007. We thank the Lord for you and look forward to what the Lord has in store for the ministry and the students during 2008. TCM's **vision** is to grow from 756 nationals to 1,200 nationals being trained by 2012 for sharing the Gospel message in their countries and regions. Your prayers and support are vital in the success of reaching this vision to reach even more souls for Christ in Europe and Central Asia.

## Immediate Need:

Construction workers for February trip

Needed: 4 individuals

Trip dates: Departure from US on Thursday, February 14 for arrival on Friday, February 15, 2008

Departure from Vienna on Saturday, March 1, 2008

Projects: General renovation type projects

Cost: Airline ticket approximately \$900+ and incidentals (two to three meals off-site of Haus Edelweiss and any souvenirs)

Please complete the PIF and Medical Consent form and return to the TCM office if you are available to serve during these dates. Please do not book your travel until you have spoken with Carol or Joshua. We do not wish to over-book the trip.

## On-going need in 2008:

If you, your small group, or your missions team would like to help TCM with the physical as well as spiritual needs of Eastern Europeans and Central Asians, we'd appreciate your assistance during 2008 in gathering the following items and sending them to the TCM office in Indianapolis (address below):

- Pre-natal vitamins
- Children's vitamins (gummy, Flintstone, etc.)
- Aspirin, Ibuprofen
- Allergy medicines
- Throat lozenges
- Cold medicine (tablet or liquid)
- Band-aids of all sizes and ointment
- Medicines for diarrhea or constipation

The TCM office will pack these items and send them overseas with our short-term workers. The Haus Staff will sort them and provide a place for the students to pick them up during each session. The students may take as much as they need back to their families and churches. Some of these items are not available, difficult to find, or difficult to obtain in their countries.

Thank you for your assistance in this small project to provide for the health and well-being of our students and their families, as well as providing an opportunity for them to share these items along with the Gospel message with those who do not know the love of Jesus.
