In pursuit of this Beyond The Walls vision steps are being taken to double the enrollment in the next 10 years to 2000. Major changes are also being made in the campus to facilitate growth and improvement. This includes the construction of an Information Commons that will combine library and technological resources, new dormitory for residential students, expansion of classroom space, renovation and updating of present buildings. This is a \$30 million dollar endeavor that will be done in phases as the money is received.
